Too Sick for School?

The Salem County Vocational Technical School District works with the Salem County Department of Health and Human Services <https://health.salemcountynj.gov/> to help protect students from spreading communicable diseases. In order to protect other students and employees it is important that these students stay home when they are too sick to come to school.

Symptoms that indicate a student is too sick to attend school

If your child has any of the following symptoms, please keep him/her home, or make appropriate arrangements. It will become necessary to pick your child up from school as soon as possible if he/she demonstrates any of the following symptoms while attending school:

- Fever – Temperature of 100.5 degrees F or higher. Student may return to school when fever-free for 24 hours (without the use of fever-reducing medicine.)
- Vomiting – A student should not return to school for 24 hours following the last episode
- Lice, Scabies
- Diarrhea
- Stiff Neck
- Rash
- Jaundice
- Skin Lesions (Sores)
- Other
